## **Dress Code and Behavioral Expectations**

CCA strives to provide fun, safe and God-honoring events. These guidelines are written with a sincere desire that ALL students who attend a CCA event have a wonderful time and are clearly informed of our expectations before arrival.

### **Dress Code:**

Boys are expected to wear appropriate clothing for each specific event (no jeans for homecoming banquet). No baggy pants or pants worn too low. Most boys will be wearing a coat, tie and slacks for this event. No clothing is allowed with alcohol or tobacco advertising; this includes shirts with distasteful or suggestive words or pictures.

Girls are expected to dress modestly. Specific guidelines are as follows:

Dresses or skirts cannot be any shorter than 4" above the knee; dresses or skirts with a slit -the slit should not be higher than 4" above the knee. No bra straps may show, no midriff may show, no lower backs exposed, and no see-through material. No strapless dresses may be worn; if your straps are not at least one inch wide, you must have a sweater. We also ask that clothing not be too tight.

### **Behavioral Expectations:**

- 1.) All students and visitors are expected to behave in a manner that is consistent with the "Student Code of Conduct." Students are expected to respect other students, staff, and parents both on and off campus.
- 2.) Students attending a CCA event are expected to behave in a manner consistent with the philosophies and policies of CCA. Visitors will be asked to leave if their behavior is contrary to CCA standards.
- 3.) CCA students who wish to bring a guest to extra curricular events are responsible to make sure their guests are dressed appropriately and their behavior is acceptable. **A signed CCA Guest Form is required and due five days before any event.** CCA Guest Forms are available through the Upper School Office.
